What are we doing and why?

Peacock & the worm are working with CFINE to produce and deliver free creative activity packs for young people and families who could benefit from them.

Peacock & the worm (formerly Peacock Visual Arts) is a registered charity based on the Castlegate in Aberdeen.

We want to support young people to improve their mental well-being, reduce loneliness and to participate in cultural activities

Peacock are working with the support of their youth advisory group who are helping to design and shape the activities in the packs

We have funding from the Inspiring Scotland's Creative communities fund to produce and deliver up to 100 activity packs every month until July 2021.



Anyone who is a beneficiary of CFINE can receive a Boredom Box, this includes:

- Young people who are food insecure
- Young people from regeneration areas in the north east, highlands and islands
- These activities are suitable for young people ages 11+, younger children may need supervision. The activities are created alongside an advisory group of 14-26 year olds

How can I get a Boredom Box?

CFINE will deliver Boredom Boxes to organisations and groups that support young people (such as social work departments, community organisations, women's groups, charities, schools etc.)
