












Remove the excess clay around your plant impression like this.






Once the clay has hardened, you can either leave it as it is or you can use your arcylic paint to decorate the impression dish like this.

TIP


When the paint has dried you can add a shiny glaze to the surface of the dish by painting a thin layer of PVA glue and letting it dry.
